IN MEMORIAM

Francisco Barajas, 75, went to be with the Lord on April 10, 2010 in San Antonio, Texas. He was born in Mexico City, January 29, 1935 and was married to his wife Frances for almost 53 years. Bro. Francisco graduated from Colegio Biblico in 1955 and later on completed studies on Christian Education at the *Baptist Theological Seminary* in Torreón, México. He ministered in Piedras Negras, Eagle Pass, and Dallas, and planted a church in Gómez Palacio, México, three in California, and two in Kansas. He also taught at Colegio during three different time periods for a total of 11 years, and after retiring, taught several correspondence courses. Francisco is survived by his wife Frances and son Caleb.
