help us PACK the PANTRY

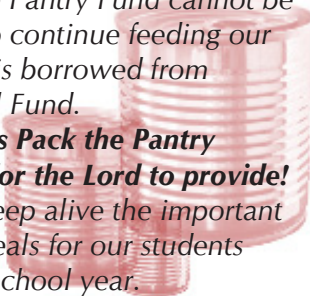
The 2009-2010 school year ended with a \$25,597 Pack the Pantry Fund deficit.
