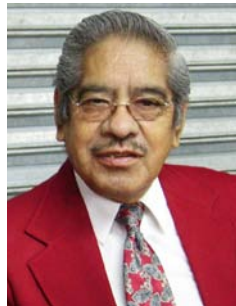
Mission Trips on the **BORDER**
